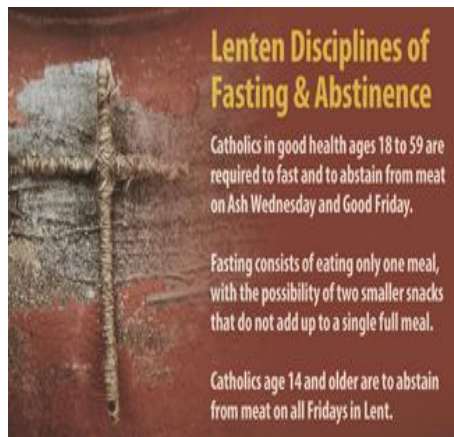

*Proclamation of the Passion of Jesus Christ, Intercessions,
Veneration of the Cross, distribution of Holy Communion*
Chaplet of Divine Mercy -- *immediately following the Passion Service*(approx. 3:00 PM)

Holy Saturday – March 31

Blessing of Easter food baskets 1:00 PM
Easter Vigil Liturgy 8:30 PM
beginning with the blessing of the “New Fire” (outside, weather permitting).
